

PARIS FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM 2023



From May 28 to June 3, 2023

The Bureau International de l'Édition Française, in partnership with SOFIA, is inviting 15 publishers from abroad to spend a professional week in Paris in order to broaden their knowledge of the French book market.

The program will take place in Paris from **May 28 to June 3, 2023**.

It is aimed at **15 foreign publishers of Literature and the Humanities (no children's books, YA, or illustrated books)**.

IT PROPOSES:

- > "B-to-B" meetings with French publishers during the **Paris Book Market, which will take place on June 1 & 2 in Paris**
- > Several round tables to discuss the main stakes of both the Humanities and Literature publishing in France and elsewhere
- > Visits to publishing houses and bookshops
- > Attending a TV or radio show related to the literary scene (if the opportunity arises)

IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE, YOU MUST

- > Be available from **May 28 to June 3, 2023** in Paris
- > Be an editorial executive/manager in **Literature or the Humanities (no children's books, YA, or illustrated books)**
- > Manage French sufficiently to be able to read a text in French and to understand someone speaking in French
- > Be able to express yourself in French or in English

FINANCIAL ASPECTS

- > **Participants' hotel bills** will be paid by the BIEF, which also pays **a per diem (50€/day)**
- > **Participants will pay their own traveling expenses**
